APPROVALS

The Board waive the first reading provision of Policy #003 and approved revisions to Policy 827 (Conflict of Interest) as recommended by PSBA.

The Board approved Darreth R. Eckert, Kelly Jeanne Goss, Dennis Klinger, Charles E. Mathis, and Laureen Vanasco as contracted drivers for Boyo Transportation for the 2020-2021 school year.

The Board approved change order #1 to the contract with Bertolet Construction Corporation due to the existence of an underground Verizon line requiring hand excavation at a cost of \$2,081.72 using Capital Reserve Funds.

The Board approved a contract with Weatherproofing Technologies, Inc. to conduct an infrared roof scan at both Fink and Kunkel Elementary Schools for a combined cost of \$3,616 in order to determine the condition of the roofs so that a proposal can be obtained for roof coating at both locations.

APPROVALS *(continued)*

The Board approved PCO 3 to the general construction contract with eciConstruction for the turf stadium project in the amount of \$1,075.00 to change the scoreboard foundation and steel support beams to allow for future installation of a different scoreboard.

The Board approved the purchase of up to 110 super wide angle lens for the iPads in elementary classrooms dedicated to remote learning from Amazon at an estimated cost of \$12.95 each using PEPPM pricing and grant funds.

The Board approved the re-establishment of a FCA (Fellowship of Christian Athletes) Club.

The Board approved the establishment of a Middle School GSA (Gender-Sexuality Alliance) Club.

The Board approved the addition of a GSA Club Advisor for the Middle School to the extracurricular schedule.

The Board amended the retirement date of Peter Fox, Middle School Science Teacher, from December 23, 2020 to January 11, 2021.

The Board authorized the Superintendent to approve change orders in an amount up to \$5,000 for the turf stadium project in order to allow project work to continue with official Board action to occur at the next scheduled meeting.

The Board approved of PCO 5 to the general construction contract with eciConstruction for the turf stadium project in the deduct amount of \$530 to change the exterior handrails at the restroom and concession steps from powder coated aluminum to galvanized steel.

The Board approved change order #2 to the contract with Bertolet Construction Corporation for the Administration Building concrete replacement project in the amount of \$3,420 for additional concrete sidewalk and concrete curbing.
