- Security of MASD building in the pm

 - Stationing a security officer outside of school building(s) door
 - Student swipe cards
 - Take one of the game ticket takers and place them at front door for security
 - Chief Visconti
 - MASD needs to limit access into buildings as much as possible
 - Randy Fox
 - Coaches/Directors/Staff are to lock outside doors before practice starts
 - Coaches/Directors/Staff are to be always present with students during practice/event
 - Outside or Inside doors are NOT to be propped open
 - High school has partitions that close that there is no access to other parts of the building
- Secure Building Vestibules
 - Randy has gone over entry procedures with building secretaries to bring consistency across the district
 - > Al phones have been put in main offices and secretaries trained
 - Secretaries are to screen an individual(s) before allowing them to enter the building
- Mandating Reporting
 - > To be kept track of in Frontline
 - Nutrition Inc. does training annually
- Workman's Compensation Flaw in System
 - Tabled until next meeting due to David Franklin not being present
- Chief Visconti Lower Swatara PD
 - Every Lower Swatara Police Officer has a MASD swipe badge except for one officer on the 3-11 shift
 - Lower Swatara will be provided with master keys to the buildings, so they are able to enter all doors in MASD buildings
